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The Board of Mayor and Selectmen of the City of West Point, Mississippi held a special called meeting the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December 2024 at 5:30 p.m. upstairs City Hall, 580 Commerce Street, West Point, Mississippi. Members present were Mayor Rodrick “Rod” Bobo presiding. Selectman Keith McBrayer, Selectman William Binder, Selectman Ken Poole via zoom and Selectmen Cole Bryan were present. 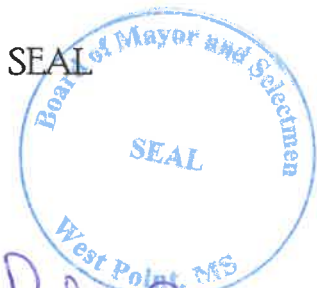
The Mayor called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.
